## **A) System Requirements**

Microsoft Windows XP<sup>®</sup>, Windows 2000, Windows Vista<sup>®</sup>  
1 Available USB Port

## **B) Packaging Contents**

- Wireless MultiMedia Keyboard
- Wireless Optical Mouse
- Wireless Micro RF Receiver
- Quick Starter Guide
- 2 AA & 2 AAA Alkaline Batteries
- CD ROM

## C) Installation

1. Plug the Micro receiver into a USB port of your computer.
2. Insert batteries into your mouse and keyboard. Your mouse supports 1 battery operation. You can insert 1 battery only or 2 batteries to double the operation time.
3. Move the mouse/keyboard within 6 feet of the receiver
4. Move the mouse to get connected with the receiver.
5. Click any keyboard key to get connected with the receiver.

Caution: before your mouse and keyboard are connected with the receiver, you need to keep the mouse and keyboard at a distance of less than 6 feet to the micro receiver to finish the initial connection

## **E) Trouble Shooting**

1. If you have any problems, check Micro receiver connection and try inserting Micro Receiver into another USB port on your computer.
2. If no connection between the mouse/keyboard and the Micro Receiver, re-insert the Micro Receiver. Take out the battery from the mouse / keyboard and reinstall it.
